Many products we use in everyday life contain raw materials of various kinds. All in all, how well informed do you feel about the raw materials processed and required as part of the manufacturing process?




In your opinion, who is primarily responsible for reducing the usage of raw materials in the manufacturing of products?


What degree of contribution can each of the following groups make to reduce the usage of raw materials?



Germany's dependence on raw materials


Germany and the EU are currently heavily dependent on imports of important, critical raw materials. How important is it for the EU and Germany to take action to reduce this heavy dependence?

Measures to reduce dependence on raw materials


The German Institute for Economic Research proposes a bundle of possible measures to reduce Germany's and the EU's dependence. Which of the following measures would you support?

Economic inequalities between countries


Many countries are poor despite having large deposits of raw materials, while countries with rather low raw material deposits are often economically more successful. Who is mainly responsible for this economic imbalance?

Mining raw materials in Germany


